Step 1 Set a date and time

For the best response, hold it on a day and at a time you know your friends and family could be free. If you're including children don't forget to host it at a good time for them and to make your playlist child-friendly.



Set up an online fundraising page to collect donations

Pick from JustGiving or Virgin Money Giving to collect donations and entry fees for the event. It's also an easy way to check off participants for your event from the list of who has paid. **JustGiving** Click on the logos on the right for instructions on how to moneygi♡ing set up a donation page.



Siep 4 Decide an entry fee or suggested donation

Set a fair entry fee to participate in the party. Too expensive and it might put people off.

Choose an **SIED 2** online platform

Choose from a variety of platforms

including Zoom, Houseparty, Skype, **Twitch** or **Whereby** to host your party.
